

List of Volunteer Positions

Position	Requirements/Comments
ASM	Assistant Stage Managing Assist the Production staff and Stage Managers with venue set-up and strike, and technical needs on site. Some heavy lifting and late evenings/early mornings are required.
CD SALES	CD Sales: A "Super Volunteer" Position We are looking for a small number of volunteers who are looking for increased responsibility. This position will involve more intensive training, running the festival Info Table, supervising 1-3 other volunteers and handling cash/credit cards, including balancing accounts. No specific skills needed, just a willingness to take charge!
DIST	Distribution (pre-festival) Festival Guide Book /poster distribution to various areas in the Lower Mainland. A car is helpful, although delivery can be done on foot within the city.
DRM	Dressing Room Monitor Monitor artist backstage and dressing rooms. A good position for those who cannot stand for long periods of time, or those looking for longer shifts. Bring a book!
FAMILY DAY	Family Day (August 15 th during the day only) Help kids make musical themed crafts and assist families at VanDusen Garden Family Day! Should be interested or experienced in working with children.
FLYER	Flyer Distribution Throughout the festival, distribute flyers near concert venues. No vehicle needed!
FOH	Front of House Assist the Front of House Managers with venue set-up, ticket-taking and cleaning up post-concert. Volunteers should be prepared to act as traffic control personnel both inside and outside of venues. <i>Flexibility required.</i>
INFO TABLE	Festival Information Table Welcome MusicFest patrons, provide festival info, facilitate festival draws and contests. May include CD sales at certain concerts – no cash handling experience required.
OFFICE	Office/Administrative Work (Both Pre-Festival and During the Festival) Assist with general office work such as answering phones, envelope stuffing, making follow-up calls, etc. Office shifts begin late June/early July and continue through the festival – a great way to get your volunteer hours! <i>Note: Must be available during regular business hours, M-F 9-5.</i>
RUNNER	Office Runner (During Festival) Stand by at the festival office for pick-ups and drop-offs and assorted office work. Sometimes, you'll be on your feet all day, and other times, you can settle into a chair and read a book. Flexibility is a must! Car/bicycle is an asset.
SITE	Site Assistance Assist the stage manager as required in all aspects of setting up and running a festival concert. Ability to lift and carry objects is a must. This is a very fun and varied position for active people!
TICKET TABLE	VIP Will Call Welcome and distribute tickets to festival VIPs. A good choice for those looking for shorter shifts.
TRANS	Artist Transportation Volunteer drivers with vehicles for airport pick-ups, returns, and transport liaison with artists. <i>Must have \$2 million liability car insurance.</i>
